

Count in the settlement of his accounts the sum of \$50 per annum for the years 1863
64, 65 & 66 for the board of Charles E. Bailey, the sum of \$34 per annum for the years
1863, 64, 65 & 66 for the board of James E. Bailey & the sum of \$30 per annum for
the years 1863, 64, 65 & 66 for the board of Joseph C. Bailey to be paid out of the
principal of the said 1860s estate.

Two writings one bearing date 10th day of 1859 and the other bearing 13th July 1862
purporting to be the last Will Testament of Geo. F. Jollicoe or George F. Jollicoff were
produced to the Court for record. And there being no subscribing witness to the writing bearing
date 12th July 1862. Mr. D. Boykin & James G. Jones being sworn severally deposed & said
they are well acquainted with the hand writing of the said Geo. F. Jollicoe, or Jollicoff, and
they believe the writing aforesaid bearing the 13th July 1862, and the name of Geo. F. Jollicoe
therein subscribed is wholly in the hand writing of the said Geo. F. Jollicoe. Whereas a certain
the opinion of the Court what accordingly ordered that the said writing bearing date the
12th day of July 1862 be recorded as and for the true last Will and Testament of the said Geo.
F. Jollicoe. And there being no executor named in the said Will on the return of
Wm. H. Postlaw who made oath according to law and together with Edward W. McLaughlin
his deputy who justified in oath as to his office, entered into and acknowledged a bond
in the penalty of four hundred dollars conditioned according to law which bond is ordered
to be recorded. Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the
estate of Geo. F. Jollicoe with his Will aforesaid annexed in due form. It being declared in
oath that the estate real and personal of the said Geo. F. Jollicoe does not exceed or value the
sum of five thousand dollars.

Ordered that the lands lying on the lands of Wm. A. McLaughlin, Esq. Moore,
Wm. P. Moore, John Williams & Emeline Bell be sold on the road of which Wm. A.
McLaughlin is surveyor.

Ordered that Samuel Kelle Sheriff of this County take into his hands the estate of
Hastwell Peter Lee and administer the same according to law.
