Upon an appeal from a judgment of a justice of the Peace,

arisen by the appellant against the appellee the 6 day of April 1864

for £35 with interest from 15 Abo 1863 & costs.

This day came the Plaintiff by their attorneys who being fully heard and the evidence adduced matricly considered, it seems to the Court that there is no error in the judgment of record. Therefore it is considered that the same be affirmed and that the appellee recover against the appellant and John H. Bragg her attorney the amount thereof, together with ten per centum for attorney's damage theron from the record 6 day of April 1864 till payment, and his costs by him in this behalf expended.

James H. Corlett having claimed an attachment against the estate of J. C. Thompson who has removed his effects out of the State so that there will not probably be sufficient within the State to satisfy the Plaintiff's claim for £34 payable 1st Sept 1864. And the Constable having made affidavit that the Defendant has no effects within his jurisdiction and that he had attached the amount in the hands of Richd P. Bryant as garnisher & summoned him to October County Court. This day came the Plaintiff by his attorney and the said Richard P. Bryant being solemnly called & duly appearing. It is ordered that he be summoned to appear here on the first day of the next Term to show cause if any he can why an attachment should not be issued against him for his said contempt.
