

14. 98 On the motion of Prob. & Dep. against Edwin B. Glend, Thomas B. Powell, J.,
H. Glend, Joseph H. Turner and W. D. Barkum. This day came the plaintiff by his attorney
and it appearing to the Court that the defendants have had legal notice of this motion they were
deliberately called but came not. Therefore it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff recover
against the defendants One hundred fifty dollars that amount being equal to one years interest
on a bond executed by the Defendants to the plaintiff as guardian of Sally J. Dudley on
the sum of \$2500 dated 2d March 17th 1860 and upon which judgment has been
returned in the Circuit Court of Southwestern County on the 10th day of November 1866.
and also that the plaintiff recover against the Defendants his costs by him in this behalf expended.

15. 48 On the motion of Prob. & Dep. against James R. Ricks & Jesse B. Vick. This day came
the plaintiff by his attorney and it appearing to the Court that the Defendants have had
legal notice of this motion they were deliberately called but came not. Therefore it is considered by
the Court that the plaintiff recover against the Defendants Forty dollars, that amount
being equal to one years interest on a bond executed by the Defendants to the plaintiff in
the sum of \$1000 due & dated March 19th 1860 and also that the plaintiff recover
against the Defendants his costs by him in this behalf expended.

14. 98 On the motion of Elijah H. Turner administrator of Edward P. Turner dec'd. against
James R. Person & W. C. Davis. This day came the plaintiff by his attorney and it
appearing to the Court that the defendant Person has had legal notice of this motion he
was deliberately called but came not. Therefore it is considered by the Court that the
plaintiff recover against the defendant Person Ninety eight dollars & twenty four
cents, which amount is equal to one years interest on a bond executed to Edward P. Turner
on December 17th 1860, and on demand the same day, by said E. P. Turner. W. C.
Davis, John A. Person & James R. Person for \$1600 25 cents; and also that the
plaintiff recover against the said E. P. Person his costs by him in this behalf expended.

14. 98 On the motion of A. P. Phillips against James D. Bryant. This day came the
plaintiff by his attorney and it appearing to the Court that the Defendant has had
legal notice of this motion he was deliberately called but came not. Therefore it is considered
by the Court that the plaintiff recover against the Defendant forty dollars this amount
being a sum equal to the interest for one year on the sum of \$668. 86. principal debt due
by the Defendant to the plaintiff by judgment in the Circuit Court of this County at May
Term 1866 and also that the plaintiff recover against the Defendant his costs by him
in this behalf expended.

14. 98 On the motion of J. M. Barkum against C. C. Magitt. This day came the plaintiff
by his attorney and it appearing to the Court that the Defendant has had legal notice
of this motion he was deliberately called but came not. Therefore it is considered by the
Court that the plaintiff recover against the Defendant One hundred and eighty dollars
equal to one years interest on the principal debt which the Defendant owes to the
plaintiff for which debt the plaintiff recovered judgment against the Defendant
at the June Term 1861 of this Court - the said principal debt being for the sum of \$300 -
and also that the plaintiff recover against the Defendant his costs by him in this
behalf expended.
