

On the motion of Barrell & Birgeant merchants in this County for leave to admit and set aside the writ of Habeas Corpus. It appears to the Court that the said Barrell & Birgeant are men of good character &c.

John Ellis is appointed Surveyor of the roads from the Signpost near Court with fees like usual. He is going in the road of James C. Lawrence who is released. And it is ordered that the usual bonds be made thereon.

On the motion of John P. Boykin for the A. Boykin against Wm R. Lawrence Jno. J. Lawrence & G. E. Johnson. This day came the plaintiff by his attorney and it appearing to the Court that the Defendant G. E. Johnson has had legal notice of this motion he was solemnly called but came not. Therefore it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff recover against the said G. E. Johnson & also a sum equal to the interest for one year on the sum of \$800 principal debt due by the Defendants to the plaintiff on a bond dated February 18 1861 - with interest thereon from this day - and also that the plaintiff recover against the said Defendant Johnson his costs by him in this behalf expended.

On the motion of Thos. Reddy against R. J. Dandoe & J. J. Dandoe. This day came the plaintiff by his attorney and it appearing to the Court that the Defendants have had legal notice of this motion they were solemnly called but came not. Therefore it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff recover against the Defendants \$86.26 with interest thereon from this day - being a sum equal to the interest for one year on the sum of \$145.73 principal debt due by the Defendants to the plaintiff by bond dated 6 day of August 1857 - and also that the plaintiff recover against the Defendants his costs in this behalf expended.

On the petition of Henry C. Briggs Charlotte W. Briggs and her next friend D. H. Thomas this day filed. This day the cause came on to be heard on the petition of Henry C. Briggs Charlotte W. Briggs and was argued by counsel. On the hearing before the Court with advice of the Court & decree that one of the Commissioners of this Court after having given notice to the debtors named in the petition of the time and place of stating their account proceed to ascertain 1st Whether Henry C. Briggs Charlotte W. Briggs and dependents for support upon the principal or interest of this said debts. 2^d If so what amount is necessary for their support for the year 1867 and apportion the same ratably upon the said debts how much each one shall pay. Stating whether the same shall be paid all at once or in installments and if in installments at what times and report the same to this Court together with any matters specially stated deemed pertinent by himself or which may be required to be so stated by any of the parties interested.

On the petition of Virginia Joy aged two years by her Guardians Thomas B. Powell this day filed.

This day the cause came on to be heard on the petition of Virginia Joy by her guardian Thos. B. Powell and was argued by counsel. On consideration whereof the Court with advice of the Court and decree that one of the Commissioners of this Court after having given due and reasonable notice to the debtors named in the said petition of the time and place of stating their account proceed to ascertain 1st Whether the petitioner Virginia Joy is dependent for support upon the principal and interest of the said debts. 2^d If so what amount is necessary for their support for the year 1867 and apportion the same ratably upon the said debts, stating how much each one shall pay, whether the same shall be paid in installment at what times & report the same to this Court with such account together with any other matters deemed pertinent by himself or which may be so requested to be so stated by any of the parties interested.
