

is Committed by the Court that the said Sterling Peterson, entered into recognizance himself in the sum of fifty dollars, with good security in the like sum of fifty dollars, for his appearance before the Court on the first day of the next March term, to answer the Commission of the peace of the County aforesaid of which he stands charged, whereupon the said Sterling Peterson, with Henry Hatis, John Stoy, Cornelius Mangel and Jackson Day, his Securities here in Court severally and respectively acknowledged themselves to be indebted to the Commonwealth of Virginia, the said Sterling Peterson in the sum of fifty dollars, and his said Securities in the like sum of fifty dollars to be respectively made and levied of their goods and chattels, lands and tenements, to the use of the Commonwealth of Virginia, if the said Sterling Peterson, shall make default in the performance of the Condition hereunder written. The Condition of the above recognizance is such, if the said Sterling Peterson, shall make his personal appearance before this Court, on the first day of March term next, then and there to answer a bill of indictment to be preferred against him by the Grand Jury, for the felony aforesaid of which he stands charged, and shall not depart therefrom without the leave of the said Court, then the above recognizance is to be void, else remain in full force and virtue.

Holmes, Constable, is prohibited from proceeding to sell under the Executions granted in the bill, but returned the property levied on to the possession of Calvin Lewis, and not to prevent further notice the further Order of this Court, but this injunction is not to be issued until Calvin Lewis, or some one for him, shall stand executed before the Clerk of this Court, a bill in the penalty of Five hundred dollars, payable to the Commonwealth, Conditioned to pay all damages which the Plaintiffs may suffer, from the awarding of this injunction.
