" It appearing to the Court that Jas. D. Vick a Constable of this County has taken on Sunday goods and chattels on the property of John D. A. Barham to satisfy Sunday excise taxes his hands being one in favor of William Briggs. One in favor of Sublett & Stephens one in favor of H. S. Howard. One in favor of R. E. Lardner. One in favor of David Branch. One in favor of Wiley Vick. One in favor of Rauls Lillard & Co. One in favor of C. M. Nicholson. One in favor of James Jones. One in favor of S. S. Little. One in favor of Mable Lardner. And it also appearing that James Holmes, who claims the said property, has executed a Sponsoring Bond with Security, ~~and the apprehension~~ of the Plaintiffs in said Excise tax, it is ordered that the said James Holmes, be summoned to the first day of the next term to try the right to the property laid on, and it is further ordered, that James D. Vick, make sale according to law, of two Acres, twenty Nags, twenty barrels of corn, and fodder, parcel of the goods and chattels laid on, that the said sale be in a credit of thirty days, that the Officer take bond and good Security, for the purchase money, and keep the same ^{subject} to the order of this Court.

Ordered that Mr. Lardner, John Williams, John S. Garner and Mr. D. A. Denny, or any three of them, let to the Court undertake the repairs of ^{the} Mount Bridge across the three creeks, receive the same when completed and make up to Court.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned until Court in Court.
