On the motion of Thomas B. Powell, against B. Holland & Meredith Hollands. This day came the plaintiff by his attorney and it appearing to the Court that the defendant had legal notice of the motion they were solemnly called but came not. Therefore it is considered by the Court that defendant recover against the defendants \$20 10 cents with interest thereon from the 16 day of December 1867 till paid, that being a sum equal to the interest for one year on \$2250 promised due by the Defendants to the plaintiff by bond dated 15 December 1866. 14 by all & due 15 Dec 1868 and so, that the plaintiff recover against the Defendants his costs by him in due behalf expended.

On the motion of Rosa G. Pipe against H. N. Briggs, J. J. Knicker & J. D. Buzant who ask & H. Lawrence are answering obligors of themselves & John A. Briggs do. This day came the plaintiff by his attorney and it appearing to the Court that the Defendants have had legal notice of the motion they were solemnly called but came not. Therefore it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff recover against the defendants \$120 with legal interest thereon from the 16 day of December 1867 till paid, that being a sum equal to the interest for one year on the sum of \$2000 principal debt due by the Defendants to the plaintiff by bond dated 15 August 1859 and payable on demand. And also that the plaintiff recover against the defendants his costs by him in due behalf expended.

On the motion of Dr. H. Barkham against Elizabeth Hunsom. This day came the plaintiff by his attorney and it appearing to the Court that the defendant has had legal notice of this motion she was solemnly called but came not. Therefore it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff recover against the defendant \$25 10 cents with interest thereon from the 16 day of December 1867 till paid, that being a sum equal to the interest for one year on the sum of \$555 87 1/2 principal debt due by the defendant to the plaintiff by a writing obligating dated January 18th 1851, and payable on demand, and also that the plaintiff recover against the defendant his costs by him in due behalf expended.

At the Motion of James Barnes Complainant against E. F. Hill and Wm. B. Briston. This day came the plaintiff by his attorney, and it appearing to the Court that the defendants had had legal notice of this Motion, and they were solemnly called and came not. Therefore it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff recover against the defendants \$55 98 with legal interest thereon from the 16th day of December 1867, till paid, that being a sum equal to the interest for one year on the sum of \$7933. Principal debt due by the defendants to the plaintiff by a writing obligating dated 18th day of November 1851, and payable twelve months after date, and also that the plaintiff recover against the defendants his costs by him in due behalf expended.
