

On the petition of Nancy S. Briggs & Caroline N. Briggs. —  
 This day other Cause Cames on again to be heard in the papers  
 formerly read, and the Report of a Commission of this Court  
 made in pursuance of a Decree entered at the November Term 1867  
 of this Court, to which no exceptions had been filed, and was  
 agreed by Counsel, on the Consideration whereof the Court doth  
 adjudge, Order and decree, that the said Report be confirmed,  
 and that Benjamin B. Bland & Charles Beale pay to David W.  
 Hines acting guardian of Nancy S. Briggs & Caroline N. Briggs  
 the sum of \$34.74 etc on bond. That Jeph C. bland and Joshua  
 V. Clark pay to the same the sum of \$14.42 etc on bond, —  
 That James H. Parker pay to the same the sum of \$58.42 etc  
 on bond. That Samson Beale & Charles Beale pay to the  
 same the sum of \$10.00 etc on bond. That Edmund Bryant pay to the  
 same the sum of \$78.54 etc on bond. That John M. Greeley and  
 Joseph H. Backus, pay to the same the sum of \$150.17 etc  
 on bond. That Leitch H. Bishop pay to the same the sum of  
 \$28.12 on bond. That Nathaniel T. Freeman and William T.  
 Francis pay to the same the sum of \$54.80 etc on bond.  
 That George W. Mays Jr. pay to the same the sum of \$7.07  
 on bond. That John Survey pay to the same the sum of \$7.42 etc  
 on bond. That Joshua V. Bland pay to the same the sum of  
 \$9.93 etc on bond. That Samson B. Merrill pay to the same the  
 sum of \$5.00 on bond. That Wm B. Soper pay to the same the sum  
 of \$5.00 etc on bond. That Nathaniel T. Francis pay to the same  
 the sum of \$10.85 etc on bond. That Thomas B. Powell pay to  
 the same the sum of \$5.85 etc on bond. That James S.  
 Westbrooks and Abbot G. Powell pay to the same the  
 sum of \$5.00 etc on bond. And the Court doth further  
 adjudge, Order and decree, that debtors above named pay  
 to the Plaintiff their costs by them incurred  
et cetera

A Writing bearing date 23<sup>rd</sup> March 1865 purporting to be the last Will & Testament of John Compton  
 do<sup>d</sup> was produced to the Court and contained little or no Test and it is ordered that the witness be called to  
 examine the next Term of this Court to prove the same.

On the motion of Rebecca Bland against Davis Barritt & James L. Soper. This day came the plaintiff  
 by her attorney and it appearing to the Court that the Defendants have had legal notice of this motion they  
 were solemnly called and sworn. Thereon it is considered by the Court that the Plaintiff recover against the  
 defendants twenty one dollars with legal interest thereon from this 16<sup>th</sup> day of December 1867 till paid  
 being a sum equal to the interest for one year on the sum of \$3.50 principal due by the Defendants to  
 the Plaintiff by bond dated 19<sup>th</sup> January 1866 and payable on demand, and on which judgment was  
 obtained at November Term 1866 of Southampton County Court. And also that the Plaintiff recover  
 against the Defendants her costs by her on the behalf expended.

Margaret A. Vogelhart orphan of David B. Vogelhart deceased by writing under her hand produced to  
 the Court and filed made choice of James B. Vogelhart for her guardian whom the Court approves, in the  
 name of Charles F. Vogelhart whose resignation the Court accepts and therewith the said James B. Vogelhart
