

and that the said Henry Powell intended to remove his effects out of this State so that there will
 not be probably showing sufficient effects where judgment is obtained, should only the ordinary price
 of law be used to allow said judgment to satisfy his claim and the said justice having first and
 attachment against the estate of the said Henry Powell returnable to this Court and James B. Vicks
 the Constable to whom the said attachment was directed having found the same on Sunday next
 the effects which had been previously found upon by the Sheriff under an attachment issued from the
 Circuit Court of this County in favor of Dennis Boycott and also summoned as garnishee Deacon
 Brown and Sam'ls Hill and as such advise with the full amount of the said Powell's effects were
 designated as being indebted to or having effects in their hands belonging to the said Henry Powell.
 This day came the plaintiff by his attorney and the defendant being solemnly called came not therefore
 it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff recover against the Defendant Henry Powell the
 hundred thirty eight dollars fifty eight cents with legal interest thereon from the 1st day of January
 1861 till paid but just to the credits before named and her costs by him in this behalf expended.
 Adolphus Powell appeared and claimed the effects attached in the hands of Deacon Brown
 and being fully heard Sunday afternoon being sworn & examined, the Court after hearing the evidence
 being of opinion that the effects attached in the hands of Deacon Brown are the property of the said
 Henry Powell doth order that the said Deacon Brown pay to the plaintiff twenty one dollars &
 three cents in full of his judgment against the said Henry Powell and as to all other matters
 this case is continued till the next Term

Ordered that the Sheriff out of any contingent moneys in his hands at this time appointed
 pay Geo. W. Sperry the amount due him for repairing the Lower Leach's bridge. and to be paid
 however until the said work is received by the Commissioners and their report returned to Court and record.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till Saturday the 28th inst. next.
