This day this cause came on again to be heard on the paper formerly read and the report of a Commissioner of the Court made present to the Court above at the December Term 1867, to which no exceptions have been filed and was agreed by counsel on the hearing whereof the Court doth adjudge, order and decree that the said report be confirmed and that Fortunatus D. Ward pay to Cap. Harris the sum of £109. 96d. on one account and two bonds, that W. M. Parker pay the sum of £163. 12d. in bonds, that W. G. T. Blumenthal pay to the sum of £12. 5d. on account, that W. H. Jones pay to the sum of £15. 9d. in bond, that Richard J. Blumenthal & W. G. T. Blumenthal pay to the sum of £3. 6d. in a writing and that John C. Blount & Joshua W. Blount pay to the sum of £11. 6d. in bonds, and the Court doth further adjudge, order and decree that the debts above named pay to S. P. Harris his costs expended about the partition aforesaid and desired.

At the Motion of Parkman Turner & Co. against James Ellis.

This day came the parties by their attorneys, who being fully heard, it is considered by the Court, that the debts of the County, out of the money arising from the sale of the property sold under the order of this County, at the last term, pay and satisfy to the Plaintiff their judgment. The balance apply to the satisfaction of a Judgment rendered before a Justice of the Peace, in favor of George J. Turner, then apply the residue of any, to the Satisfaction of a Judgment rendered by the last term of this County, in favor of Mr. & Mrs. James against Parkman Turner. If any balance then remains, pay it over to the Defendants.

Ordered that Sam'l. Cutts, Sheriff of this County, take into his hands the Estate of James J. Turner, deceased, and administer the same according to Law.

Ordered that Sam'l. Cutts, Sheriff of this County, take into his hands the Estate of Andrew J. Turner deceased and administer the same according to Law.
