

The Court doth assigne Barton J. Jones guardian of T. R. Coats & Co. & P. A. Jones
 nephews of Colonel Thomas Coats deceased, to be together with George At. Jones Benjamin B.
 Jones his executor, who justified on oath as to their sufficiency, entered into and acknowledged
 a bond in the penalty of five hundred dollars conditioned according to law which bond is ordered
 to be recorded. It being declared on oath that the Estate real & personal of the said nephews does not
 exceed in value the sum of One thousand dollars.

The Court doth assigne James J. Harrison guardian of L. O. Holt & Effie J. Holt nephews
 of James J. Holt deceased, who therupon he together with Father M. Bishop & William L. Laid his
 executors entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One thousand dollars conditioned
