Thence Blunt who stands indicted of house breaking appeared in Court in discharge of her recognizance entered into in this Court at November Term last and was set to the bar in custody of the Sheriff of this County and being there arraigned pleaded not guilty to the indictment whereupon came a jury consisting of Messrs. Wm. H. Bryant, Emmet Howell, John Williams, Richard S. Jordan, Amos B. Cook, Geo. Breckinridge, J. A. Borchard, Stephen J. Watkins, Jonathan Borden, Jos. B. Davis, Wm. S. Stephenson & J. L. Dolis who being duly sworn and sworn the truth of and upon the promise to speak and having heard the evidence upon their oath do say that the said Blunt is guilty of the felony aforesaid in manner and form as in the indictment against her is alleged and they ascertain the term of her imprisonment in the Penitentiary to be twelve months and thereupon being demanded if her if any thing she had to say why the Court have to adjourn and recede as against her should not remove the said and nothing being offered or alleged in reply if judgment is considered by the Court that the said Blunt be imprisoned in the Penitentiary of this Commonwealth for the term of twelve months the period of the jurors aforesaid was proclaimed. And it is ordered that the Sheriff of this County as soon as possible after the adjournment of this Court, remove and safely convey the said Thence Blunt from the jail of this County to the said Penitentiary there to be kept imprisoned and treated in the manner directed by law. And thereupon the said Blunt is remanded to jail.

The defendants say they are not guilty in manner and form as in the indictment against them, all eight of the jury put themselves on the country and the Commonwealth Attorney and Sheriff came a jury to wit Arthur Whitley, Wm. Hunt W. A. Bell, John Pope, John C. Bell, Joshua Bryant, Elijah Williams, Wm. H. Barlow, Owen Whitely, John Harris, Franklin Webb & Edward French, who being duly sworn, and sworn the truth to speak upon the foregoing, and upon their oath returned a verdict in these words to wit "We do say my friend the Defendant John Bell is guilty and all of the facts are true. We find the defendant Bird not guilty." Therefore it is awarded that the Commonwealth recover against the defendant John Bell the sum of one and the fine by the jury adjudged and the costs of the prosecution. And as to the defendant Bird it is considered by the Court that he go where of without day.
