Richardson Barrett who stands committed to the Gaol of this County charged a felony by him committed, it was this day brought to the Court and on his institution all orders were had for his appearance before the Court on the first day of May next to answer the remonstrance of and concerning the felony whereof he standeth hereunder named and charged - the said Richardson Barrett doth dwell in the town of Fife with good means in the like sum which recognizance may be taken before any Justice of the Peace out of Court.

Joseph Connell, of Fife, who stands charged with being the father of the child of Mary Lewis a single white woman was delivered up to Court in discharge of his recognizance and being fully bound on the said Mary Lewis and the said Joseph Connell and biding were sume & sufficient consideration whereof it is the opinion of the Court that the said Joseph Connell is not the father of the said bastard child. Therefore it ordeneid that he be acquitted & discharged.

Stephen Boykin who stands indicted of house breaking, was this day solemnly called but came not therfore it is ordered that a Bill of Capias be issued against the said Stephen Boykin notwithstand he to die May Term next.

John Ravelle who stands indicted of house breaking, was this day solemnly called but came not. Therfore it is ordered that a Bill of Capias be issued against the said John Ravelle notwithstanding he to die May Term next.

Ordered that Samuel Kello Sheriff of this County take into his hands the estate of Andrew R. James & administrate the same according to law.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term.
