

considered by the Court that the said Stephen Boykin be imprisoned in the penitentiary of this Commonwealth for the term of twelve months, the period by the jurors in their verdict ascertained, and it is ordered that the Sheriff of this County do as soon as possible after the adjournment of this Court remove and safely convey the said the said Tom Back from the jail of this Court to the said Penitentiary, where he is to be kept imprisoned and treated in the manner directed by law. And thereupon the said Stephen Boykin is remanded to jail.

Ordered that A. S. Stephenson, Zachariah T. Johnson & John Campb. being first duly sworn for the purpose do appear all the goods & chattels of David H. Joyner dec. that may be produced or shown to them and return the same in pursuance under their hands to the Clerk of this Court.

John Ruelle who stands Indicted of house breaking was taken to the bar in custody of the Jailor of this Court and the Clerk of the said John Ruelle is continued till the next term. And on the motion of the said John Ruelle he is allowed to give bail himself to be bound in the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars with good security on the like sum of two hundred and fifty dollars conditioned for the personal appearance of the said John Ruelle before this Court on the first day of June Term next by Eleazer O. Black in the morning, to answer the Commonwealth of and concerning the felony of which he stands indicted. Whereupon the said John Ruelle with David Vick his security here in Court severally acknowledged and subscribed in writing to the Commonwealth of Virginia the said John Ruelle in the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars and the said David Vick in the like sum of two hundred and fifty dollars, of their respective goods and chattels, land and tenements to be liable to the use of the said Commonwealth if the said John Ruelle shall make default in performance of the conditions aforesaid.

The condition of the above recognizance is such that if the above bound John Ruelle shall make default as aforesaid under his personal appearance before this Court on the first day of June Term by Eleazer O. Black in the morning then and there to answer the Commonwealth for and concerning the felony of which he stands indicted and shall not depart thence without leave of the Court then the above obligation to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue.

Ordered that John James be required to remove the raft from George's bridge immediately and present his claim at James Court next.

Tom Back who stands Indicted of house breaking was this day set to the bar by the Jailor of this Court and being sworn of arraigned & pleaded not guilty to the Indictment whereupon came a jury to wit E. B. Fines, L. H. Fines, James Vaughan, Robert A. Williams, Edwin Prosser, David H. Johnson, J. O. Johnson, Ding D. Bryant, Preston B. Bryant, David H. Kinkeade, Richard H. Johnson & A. S. Stephenson who being sworn according to law tried and sworn the truth to speak of upon the evidence, and having heard the evidence upon their oaths returned a verdict in these words to wit: We the jury find the prisoner guilty and affix his term of imprisonment in the Penitentiary to one year. And thereupon at being demanded of the said Tom Back if any thing for himself he had or knew to say why the Court here should not now proceed to pronounce judgment against him according to law and nothing being offered or alleged in delay of judgment it is considered by the Court that the said Tom Back be imprisoned in the Penitentiary of this Commonwealth for the term of One year, the period by the jurors in their verdict ascertained. And it is ordered that the Sheriff of this County do as soon as possible after the adjournment of this Court remove and safely convey the said Tom Back from the jail of this Court to the said Penitentiary, where he is to be kept imprisoned, and treated in the manner directed by law. And thereupon the said Tom Back is remanded to jail.
