Ordered that the Sheriff of this County collect from each male person above the age of sixteen years, not exempt from the payment of taxes or duties, three pence, or Guardian the sum of two dollars & seventy five cents, & levy on lands and other property, up to the date taxes within this County & on the interest and profits mentioned in the 29th, the yearly income in the 31st, and the fee in the 32nd Sections of the 35th Chapter of the Code of Virginia, on which taxes and apportionments against persons residing in this County are levied & fifty per cent on the assessed tax, thereon to pay and discharge the foregoing allowances made this day and there made by the last Terms of this Court, including and years interest on the County bonds sold under the order of Court of 31st Dec. 1863, and the balance of any relief in his hands subject to the order of this Court.
