Bryant his Surety, both justified and took unto his sufficiency entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of one thousand dollars, conditioned according to law, which said hearing a stamp of the Seal of the Judicial records of the United States to the amount of one dollar being affixed thereto & duly cancellled is ordered to be recorded.

For reasons appearing to the Court it is ordered that one of the executors of the poor of this County bind out to Daniel Chapman, as apprentices William Hamer aged nine years and John Hamer aged four years, and generally with the said Daniel Chapman that he is to pay the said apprentices at the expiration of the term of their apprenticeship two hundred dollars each.

On the motion of George W. Gano & Bro. for permission to receive and drink spirits of their slave in this County till the last day of April next, the Court certifies that the place is suitable & convenient and that the applicants are persons of sobriety & good character.

Luke Faulkner who stands indicted of Horsestealing appeared in Court in discharge of his recognizance entered into at the last Term of the Court and was set to the bar in custody of the Sheriff of this County, thereof arraigned pleaded not guilty to the indictment.
