

period of seven years." And on the motion of the said Luke Falkner and for reasons appearing to the Court it is ordered that the said verdict be set aside and that a new trial be had upon the indictment aforesaid. And therefore he is remanded to jail.

Wiley Whitfield was this day led to the bar in custody of the jailor of this Court and the grand jury having returned the indictment against him for "burglary" not a true bill. If arraignment was made as the manner is, and nothing further appearing or being alleged against him it is ordered that he be discharged from his imprisonment.

Eloja Barrett who was summoned to appear here this day as a witness for the Commonwealth against John Russell was this day solemnly called but came not. Therefore on the motion of the Attorney for the Commonwealth it is ordered that she be summoned to appear here on tomorrow to show cause if any she can why an attachment should not be issued against her for her said contempt.

Gieson, Jesse B. Vick, W. W. Branch, John Bradshaw, W. Smith, Robert Ridley & Joseph W. Olant one dollar each for fees served as grand jurors at this term, to be paid out of the County treasury.
