

The parties plaintiff & Defendants consenting & agreeing that the trial by jury in this case should be waived, and that the same be tried & decided by the Judge, & that upon this case came in to be tried upon the evidence, & upon proof of the fact, that the contract upon which this action is founded, was made and executed at it referred to (Confederate States Treasury Notes, as a Standard of Value, in consideration whereof it is conceded by the Court, that the Plaintiff received against the Defendant Eight Dollars & twenty cents upon terms from 1st 31st of December 1864, the said, and this Court by this Court his duty in this behalf expended—

Now Shewed, Eliza Barrister, Margaret Worrell, Geo. E. Tice & others & others, W^m Jones, E. B. King, Martin Whitehead & W^m Dick, were recognized bond in Court, separately and individually, acknowledged themselves separately & individually to be indebted to the Commonwealth of Virginia in the sum of One Hundred dollars to be levied of each of them first and chiefly, and to be levied to the use of the Commonwealth of the State, which stated default in the performance of the condition underwritten. The condition of this recognizance is that if the above named Eliza Barrister, Eliza Barrister, Margaret Worrell, Geo. E. Tice, Jones & others, W^m Jones, E. B. King, Martin Whitehead and W^m Dick, and every of them separately appear before this Court, having first appearing ten dollars to give as a bond to the Commonwealth against John Russell who stands charged with felony, and do not deposit thereof within the time of said Court, then the recognizance to be void, otherwise to remain in full force & Virtue.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till tomorrow morning 10 O'clock
