And it is ordered that the Sheriff of this County, do as soon as possible after the adjournment of this Court, receive & safely convey the said Richard Potts, from the jail of this County to the said Penitentiary, there to be kept imprisoned and confined in the manner directed by law, and thereupon the said Richard Potts is removed to jail."

On motion of Frances R. Darden, next friend of Walter S. Darden, and now a ward of John B. Jenkins, Ordered that the said John B. Jenkins be summoned to appear before this Court at the next September Term and show cause if any he can, why his authority as guardian of the said Walter S. Darden should not be revoked and annulled.
