The Defendant being arrested under the writ of Capias awarded against him in the
case he was brought into Court, and the Court having heard the case and doth order
that the said Defendant be imprisoned in the jail of this County, the term of
one month and afterwards until he pay the costs of this process or is otherwise
discharged by due course of law.

Richard Flirtz who stands indicted for High Treason, was set to stand in custody
of the Sheriff of this County, Sheriff assigned pleader not ready to be Indicted,
whereupon came a day to wit Robert St. Williams, a Justice of the Common Pleas, Justice
Dearborn, John Francis, A. L. Stephenson, Harry Turner, George W. Cady, George
H. Lyford, Franklin Fish, H. A. Stephenson, H. A. Altham and Richard D.
Clyburn, who being called stand and sworn the truth of and upon the premises to
State, and having heard the evidence upon this said he sayeth the Court further
orders that the Defendant stand and suffer the term of his imprisonment in the Penitentiary
Barber House and thereupon it being demanded of the said Richard Flirtz if he
of anything for himself he held or knew to say why the said Plaintiff did
not proceed to pronounced judgment against him according to law, and failing
thus offered to alledge in delay of judgment, it is considered by the Court that the
said Richard Flirtz be confined in the Penitentiary of this Commonwealth for the
term of twelve months, the period by the Juries in their verdict determined
and it is Ordered that the Sheriff of this County do as soon as possible after the
affirmance of this Court, remove & safely convey the said Richard Flirtz from
the jail of this Court to the said Penitentiary, wherein to be kept imprisoned
till such time as he can be tried by law, and throughout the said Richard Flirtz is
remanded to fail.

On motion of Francis R. Darden next friend of Walter G. Darden, now
and now a widow of James B. Jenkins, Ordered that the said James B. Jenkins
be summoned to appear before this Court at the next September Term and shall
examine if any he can why his authority as guardian of the said Walter G. Darden
should not be revoked and annulled.

Ordered that the Sheriff summon all the acting Justices of this County to the
first day of the next Term to consider and decide whether or not there shall be
