This day this cause came on to be heard again on the papers formerly
 read and the report of Wm B. Stennis one of the Commissioners of this Court made pursuant to a decree
 rendered at the August Term 1863 and to which no exceptions have been filed and was argued by Counsel
 On the consideration whereof the Court doth adjudge, order and decree that Roy B. Knicker & Charles
 Beale pay to David H. Thomas acting guardian of Caroline W. & Mary C. Briggs the sum of
 \$113.17 on bond, that John B. Glantz & Joshua W. Glantz pay the same the sum of \$28.35 on
 bond, that James W. Parker & John D. Chamberlayne pay the same the sum of \$107.97 on bond -
 that Samuel Beale & Charles Beale pay the same the sum of \$14.02 on bond - that John M.
 Gurley & Joseph B. Packham pay the same the sum of \$20.86 on bond, that Seth W. Washburn
 pay the same the sum of \$37.76 on bond, that George A. Maynard will pay the same the sum of
 \$10.43 on bond - that John Quincy will pay the same the sum of \$10.43 on bond - that Joshua V. Glantz will pay
 the same the sum of \$14.02 on bond. that Samuel B. Morrill pay the same the sum of \$7.07 on
 bond. that John Taylor & Thomas B. Powell pay the same the sum of \$9.50 on bond. that James D.
 Webster & William B. Powell pay the same the sum of \$7.33 on bond. And the Court doth further
 adjudge, order and decree that the debtors above named on this decree pay to David H. Thomas
 the sum of \$1000 as aforesaid to be held by him in this petition or such expended.

Ordered that Levi Stephenson, D. L. Dolis, R. W. Clayton & Jas. H. Enquest or any three of
 them let to the lowest undertaker the repairs of Round hill Swamp bridge, within the same when completed to
 make a report

On the motion of Col. Thomas L. Flannery. It is ordered that the Sheriff summon all the acting
 Justices of this County to the first day of October Term next, to take into consideration the subscription to

On the motion of H. L. Howard. It is ordered that all the Justices of this County be summoned
 to the first day of October Term to take into consideration the repairs or erection of an embankment nearly
 the low grounds of Atterbury at Dorchester
