It being desired on and established where and payment of the said Nancy Kitchin deceased record in value the sum of \$1000.

Poynter for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Edmund E. Kitchin deceased as before.

Ordered that Mrs. J. Beale, Mrs. H. Stephenson, and James Drury being first duly sworn for the purpose do appraise all the goods & chattels belonging to the estate of Edmund E. Kitchin deceased & return the appraisement under their hands to the Clerk of this County.
