States of the amount of One dollar affixed thereto and duly cancelled is ordered to be recorded. Certificate is granted to said James C. Drury for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Edmund C. Kitchin dec^d in due form.

Ordered that Geo. J. Bishop, Geo. P. Stephenson, and James Drury being first duly sworn for the purpose do appraise all the goods & chattels belonging to the estate of Edmund C. Kitchin dec^d & return the appraisement under their hands to the Clerk of this Court.
