Ordered that P. J. Holmes, S. H. Holmes & Jas. B. Jones with the Commissioners of Able of Wright County let to the lowest bidder the repairs of the Broad Water Bridge bridge Black Water river near the same when completed & make report to County.

The Court having been summoned for do purpose and taking the subject into consideration doth order that there be two additional grand Jurors sworn in this Court one at the June quarterly Term & the other at the September quarterly Term of this Court.

Ordered that Jo. C. Warren & John B. Higgins let to the lowest bidder the repairing of the ferry at a price not exceeding our hundred fifty dollars Seventy five dollars per year.

Dick Shepherd who stands committed to Jail until he pay the costs of the proceedings against him is for reasons appearing to the Court ordered to be discharged forthwith from his imprisonment.

Oliver N. Rarford is appointed Surveyor of the roads in the town of Thomas J. Norriston who is named.

The Commissioners appointed to let to the lowest bidder the rebuilding of a bridge across mill creek known as ^{the} bridge this day made report which the Court approves.

On the motion of Dr. E. Gillette who sues for the benefit of at the costs of Monroe & Co. against Dick N. Bishop demanding obligor of himself & Dr. L. Bishop & Dr. T. Smith. This day came the plaintiff by his attorney and the debt being solemnly called and not appearing it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff sues against the debt for \$16.66 cents being a sum equal to the interest for two years on the sum of \$138.91 principal debt due by Dr. N. to Dr. E. by judgment rendered in the Circuit Court of Southampton County - with interest thereon from this day till paid: and his costs in this behalf expended.

States of the sum of one dollar affixed and duly cancelled - It being declared on oath that the within real personal does not exceed in value the sum of \$50.00.
