

To certify the conduct made by the Commissioners for the repair of the said bridge - and the Court doth order that James C. Schell, Daniel W. Goff, & J. G. Little, present to let to the lowest undertaker the repairs of the bridge of record for a sum not exceeding the sum of \$500. according to the specifications in the aforesaid report & make report to Court.

Ordered that P. J. Holmes, S. D. Holmes & Jas. A. Jones with the Commissioners of Isle of Wight County let to the lowest undertaker the repair of the Broad Water Bridge being Black Water river receive the same when completed & make report to County.

The Court having been summoned for its purpose and taking the subject into consideration doth order that there be two additional grand juries ^{to be drawn} in this Court one at the June quarterly Term & the other at the December quarterly Term of this Court.

Ordered that Jas. G. Warren & John B. Higgins let to the lowest undertaker the repairing of the ferry at a price not exceeding one hundred eighty dollars seventy five dollars per year.

Dick Shepherd who stands committed to jail until he pay the costs of his prosecution against him is for reasons appearing to the Court ordered to be discharged forthwith from his imprisonment.

The Commissioners appointed to let to the lowest undertaker the rebuilding of a bridge over mill swamp known as Village bridge this day made report which the Court approved.

On the motion of Jas. E. Gillett who sue for the benefit & at the cost of Monroe Corp. against Richd H. Bishop demanding obligor of himself & Jas. L. Bishop & T. Smith. This day came the plaintiff by his attorney and the Dft. being solemnly called and not appearing. It is considered by the Court that the plaintiff recover against the Dft. for \$16. 66 containing a sum equal to the interest for two years on the sum of \$13. 91 principal debt due by Dft. to plff. by judgment rendered in the Circuit Court of Burlington County - with interest accrued from the day till paid. and his costs in this behalf expended.
