Thereupon it is considered by the Court that the power of habeas corpus is due to date John B. Jenkins as guardian of the said Hobbs S. Dardur be ordered to furnish and that the said John B. Jenkins pay to the said Walter S. Dardur his costs.

✓ Walter S. Dardur, nephew of Hobbs Dardur above the age of fourteen years made choice of Robert S. Peper for his guardian whereupon the said Robert S. Peper with Francis R. Dardur his attorney who justified or oath as to her sufficiency, interested and acknowledged a bond in the sum of five hundred dollars conditioned according to law, which bond bearing a stamp of the national revenue of the U. States affixed thereto and duly executed, is ordered to be recorded.

Samuel Kelly Sheriff of this County this day produced several lists of delinquents for the non-payment of Capital and Property Tax for the years 1866-67 & 68 with the rolls of the County Sheriff at the foot thereof thereto subscribed and accompanied by the written opinion of the Commissioner of the Revenue touching the propriety of said lists and each was then examined and verified by the other sheriffs present, which said lists after being examined and corrected by the said date ordered that a copy thereof be certified to the Auditor of Public Accounts by the Clerk of this County.

Henry Blair who stands indicted for Malicious Shooting this day affirming in Court in discharge of his recognizance entered into of the lady Anna Bond of this County and was set to the bar in custody of the Sheriff of this County thereof awaiting & pleaded not guilty. Whereupon came a Jury to try him: William Beale, Thomas Vaughan, David H. Thomas, Joseph Davis, C. C. Vaughan, Allen St. Collins, Amos J. Peper, John Sofers, James St. Williams, George Moore, William St. Williams and Jonathan Leckie who being sworn tried & found the said Henry Blair guilty of the said crime and having heard the evidence upon him did so say. He the Jury find the prisoner guilty and ascertain the time of his confinement in the Penitentiary for five years, and therefore it being demanded of the said Henry Blair if anything for himself he had or knew to say why he could stand no more proceed to pronounced judgment giving him according to law & nothing being offered to alledged in defense of judgment. It is therefore ordered by the Court that the said Henry Blair be confined in the Penitentiary of this Commonwealth for the term of five years the period to the Juries in their trial ascertained. And it is ordered that the Sheriff of this County do at soon as possible after the adjournment of this Court remove and safely carry the said Henry Blair from the jail of this City to the said Penitentiary Prison the said kept imprisoned and treated in the manner directed by law and moreover the said Henry Blair is remanded to jail.
