

Ordered that the account of Henry LaHorned jailor of this County amounting to forty four dollars & seventy five cents be certified to the Auditor of Public Accounts for his receipt and payment.

On the return of Walter E. Darden by writ process against John B. Jenkins. This day came the said H. E. Darden by his next friends and the summons awarded against the said John B. Jenkins returned by him and he being solemnly called came not therefore it is ordered by the Court that the process of habeas corpus of the said John B. Jenkins as guardian of the said Walter E. Darden be revoked & cancelled and that the said John B. Jenkins pay to the said Walter E. Darden his Costs.

Walter E. Darden nephew of Willie Darden above the age of fourteen years made choice of Robert E. Pope for his guardian whereupon the said Robert E. Pope with Francis B. Darden his parents who justified on oath as to his sufficiency, entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five hundred dollars conditioned according to law, which bond having a receipt of the national revenue of the U. States affixed thereto and duly cancelled, is related & returned.

Samuel Kelle Sheriff of this County this day produced several lists of delinquents for the non payment of Contribution & property tax for the years 1868 '69 & '69 with the rolls of the delinquent Sheriffs at the first return of thereto subscribed and accompanied by the written opinion of the Commissioners of the Revenue touching the propriety of said lists and each case therein contained, and also the roll already named, which said lists after being examined and corrected by the Court did order that a copy thereof be certified to the Auditor of Public Accounts by the Clerk of the Court.

Henry Blend who stands indicted for Malicious Shooting this day appeared in Court in discharge of his recognizance and entered into of the last found bond of this Court and was set to the bar in custody of the Sheriff of this County thereof arraigned & pleaded not guilty. Whereupon came a jury to wit: William Bruce, Thomas Thompson, David H. Thomas, Joseph Davis, Geo. Vanhook, Allen H. Collier, et al. J. Pope, John Lykes, James H. Williams, George Moore, William D. Williams and Jeremiah Darden who being selected tried & showed the truth and upon the evidence given and having heard the evidence upon their oath do say that the jury find the prisoner guilty and ascertain the term of his confinement in the Penitentiary for five years, and thereupon it being demanded of the said Henry Blend if anything for himself he had or knew to say why the Court should not send proceed to pronounced judgment against him according to law & nothing being offered or alleged in reply of forgiveness. It is therefore considered by the Court that the said Henry Blend be confined in the Penitentiary of this Commonwealth for the term of five years the period to the jurors in their being ascertained. And it is ordered that the Sheriff of this County do as soon as possible after the adjournment of this Court remove and safely convey the said Henry Blend from the jail of the County to the said Penitentiary according to his rights imprisoned and treated in the manner directed by law and thereupon the said Henry Blend is remanded to the jail.
