

On the motion of a Divisional Committee for leave to have a grant issued to be granted and delivered at Franklin in due till the first day of April next & appear to the Court that that the said Divisional Committee is a person of full discretion and ability and that the place is a good and sufficient for the neighbourhood.

Ordered that Thos. G. Gates, Mr. B. Saunders, & C. C. Mayot & to the aforesaid way of having such being first duly sworn for that purpose do affirm all the goods & chattels of John Hilditch & return the aforesaid instrument under their hands to the Clerk of this Court.

The last, 2nd & returning of George S. Judson and was found by the Clerk of allay of Standard re of the returning witness above & ordered to be record.

Ordered that Edward Weston, John W. Harrison & Asaph B. Curtis being first duly sworn for the purpose do affirm all the goods & chattels of John Hilditch & return the aforesaid instrument under their hands to the Clerk of this Court.

Ordered that John St. Bishop, T. D. Tracy & James St. Bishop being first duly sworn for the purpose do affirm all the goods & chattels of the Estate of Tracy died & return the aforesaid instrument under their hands to the Clerk of this Court.

Ordered that Joseph E. Marrot, P. Whited A. Gay & Dr. B. Higgins did to the Court administer the taking of oaths and Anthony provided the sum of one hundred & 75 per year.

It appears of by an order made at the September Term 1868 of this Court that all the acting Justices of the County were summoned to the Term of the Court & that the same has been rescheduled to have it held on Wednesday the 20th of October at Franklin in due course of time & following term of the County Court of Franklin to any point they may direct. Notwithstanding however it is ordered that the following five Commissioners be appointed, any three of whom may act, viz., Dr. W. L. Parker, W. W. Briggs, Dr. C. S. Bartland, James Williams and James Devalley to be to the Clerk Underwriter the construction of an embankment from the station of the bridge over following River of Franklin to any point they may direct. Notwithstanding however it is ordered that the same has been rescheduled to the tenth of October, subject to the further Order of this Court, provided the same will be more than three hundred dollars and it is ordered further that the said Commissioners make report to this Court at the next Term of.
