Fox, Gordon House & Bayliss Griffis, for committing and aiding & abetting to the body of Collins Powell, on the 10th day of August 1868, and the evidence of Collins Powell, shown in Court and sent to the Grand Jury at his own request. - We present John Bowe for polygamy in this to wit, that he did feloniously steal take & carry away from Charles Beck on the 20th day of August 1868, of the value of \$5.00 the evidence of Charles Beck at his own request. - We present Samuel Davis & A. B. Lewis, for breaking and entering by breaking together in publick at James St. Hertel's on the 25th day of August 1868, and the evidence of John S. Turner, sent to the grand jury at their request. - We present the rocks found in Mound to whom Hunt comes, and the evidence of Joseph G. Brumfield, Elliott C. Ferguson town of and body. - We present William Fawcett & John E. Remond for cohabiting together unlawfully, and the evidence of Philip Corson, shown in Court & sent to the Grand Jury of their request. - We present Reed C. Gray & Gap Berlin for cohabiting together unlawfully, and the evidence of Philip Corson, shown in Court & sent to the Grand Jury of their request. - We present John Powell (L.D.) & Abby James for cohabiting together unlawfully, and the evidence of E. C. Ferguson, shown in Court & sent to the Grand Jury of their request. -

And the said grand jury having nothing further to present were discharged. - On the Motion of Bob Brown, It is ordered that Sam'l H. Hildreth be appointed Justice in a Sub of Court created by Willard Brown for the benefit of Con't Davis, as placed to Jno. Shantz, trustee, who has done his duty. -

Ordered that Sam'l Hildreth, Sheriff of this County, take into his hands the Estate of Robert Cook died & administer the same according to law. -

Ordered that E. Baldwin, A. H. Hinckley and John Stevens, being justly sworn for the purpose, do appraise all the goods & chattels of the Estate of Robert Cook died & return the appraisement under their hands to the Clerk of the Court.

On the Motion of Mary Ann Jepson, widow of Paul Jepson it is ordered that John Camp, A. B. Stephenson & J. S. Johnson, or any two of them, do appraise with the aid of proper scales and stands one third of the real estate whereof her husband owned and left Jepson & son, and property, and make report to the Court.

On the Motion of Elliott C. Ferguson, who made out and together with fresh Ferguson & Richard L. Bryant, the Surveyors, who testified no land to be there sufficiently entered into and acknowledged a land in the name of Tim Steiner to Dethers, condemned according to law, which land being a stamp of the Int. Off. of the U. States, to the amount of one dollar, affid value & duly concurred, is ordered to be received. Certificate is granted to the
