Sims, James Hartley, George Stephenson, E. W. Scott, Garrett Bolton, Robert Bell, David Simonds, Giles Pope, Richard Miller, Moses Hayes, Joshua Bryant & Charles Lewis, who being called to witness the Court to speak upon the issue joined, upon their last returned & verdict in these words: "We the Jury find the Defendant Henry Stoy not guilty, and find the Defendant Jenkins guilty & assess his fine to ten dollars." Therefore it is Considered by the Court, that the Commonwealth recover against the Defendant Jenkins the sum of eight dollars, as aforesaid & the costs of the prosecution, and as to the Defendant Stoy, it is Considered by the Court that he go therefrom without day.

James Buck who stands indicted of second breaking, was this day sent to the bar in custody of the jailor of this Court, being thereof arraigned pleads not guilty to the Defendant, whereupon came to Court to wit, Joshua Bryant, Giles Pope, Amos S. Scott, who being called to witness the Court to speak upon the issue joined, & having heard the evidence, upon their last returned & verdict in these words: "We the Jury find the prisoner guilty, & assessment the term of his imprisonment in the Penitentiary to be two years," and therefore it is demanded of the Clerk Clerks Books if anything for himself he has or know to say, why the Court demand not now proceed to pronounced judgment against him according to law, and nothing being offered or alleged in delay of judgments, It is Considered by the Court that the said James Buck, be imprisoned in the Penitentiary of the Commonwealth for the term of two years, the period of the prison in this Court according, and it is Ordered that the Sheriff of this County do as soon as possible after the pronouncing of this Court, remove & safely convey the said James Buck from the jail of this County, to the State Penitentiary, thence to be kept imprisoned & treated in the Manner directed by law, and therefore the said James Buck is demanded to jail.
