

to collect judgments in the name of the Court each, besides the cost, charged by the agent of the attorney for the Commission out, it is considered by the Court, that the Commission will recover against the Defendants, the sum of two hundred and the cost of this proceeding.

This day the cause came on to be tried on the petition, &c. appearing to the Court, that the trustees of the said Nottoway tribe of Indians had duly summoned & had failed to show cause why the prayer of the petition should not be granted. The Court doth therefore order & direct that Thomas B. Howell, who is hereby appointed a Special Commissioner for that purpose, proceed to ascertain the interests of the said Nottoway Indians, in the real & personal estate held in common by the Nottoway tribe of Indians & report the same to Court, with any report which he may be required by either of the parties to report, in which he may draw proceedings.

The Court doth order that hereafter every case to be tried at the June & November term, every Term of the Court & at the March & August quarterly Terms should be held for that purpose. And it designates all the said quarterly Terms of the Court to wit, March, June, August, & November, as terms for the trial of proceedings for misdemeanors.

That the return of James S. Howell, who spoke Court & reported that Charles Howell his knowledge (who justified on oath as to his Sufficiency) entered into & acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Eight hundred dollars, conditioned according to law, which bond having a Stamp of the Seal, Rev. of the N. States to the amount of one dollar affixed thereto & duly Committed, is ordered to be recorded. And it is granted the said James S. Howell, for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Richard B. Ferguson died in due form. It being declared in oath that the estate real & personal does not exceed in value the sum of \$1000.

George F. Bice is appointed Surgeon of the next trading year from the District into in the place of Thomas W. Shubert. And it is ordered that the same hold its date.

Ordered That the acting Justice of this County be summoned to the first day of the next Term, to examine the proposals for the rebuilding of Fowles Landing at the instance of Joseph Grayson.

Ordered that all the acting Justices of this County be summoned to the first day of the next Term to consider the proposals for rebuilding Fowles Landing & propriety of satisfying and confirming the report of the Commissioners the day fixed for the rebuilding of Camp Landing.
