

to collect judgments in the sum of two Cent each, besides the cost, therefore by the award of the attorney for the Commission, it is awarded to the costs, that the Commission shall recover against the Defendants the sum of two Cent each and the costs of this proceeding.

Defendants of the Nottoway tribe of Indians

This day the Cause came on to be heard on the petition, & it appearing to the Court, that the trustees of the said Nottoway tribe of Indians have been duly summoned & have failed to show Cause why the prayer of the petition should not be granted. The Court doth therefore order & direct, that Thomas B. Worrell, who is hereby appointed a Special Commissioner for that purpose, proceed to ascertain the interests of the said Nottoway Burmans, in the real & personal estate held in Common by the Nottoway tribe of Indians & report the same to Court, with any Report which he may be required by either of the parties to supply, in which he may deem proper.

The Court doth order that hereafter every term to hold at the Court & otherwise, every Term of the Court & at the March & August quarterly Terms thereof, shall be for that purpose. And it designates all the said quarterly Terms of the Court to wit, March, June, August, & November as terms for the trial of proceedings for Misdeemeanors.

At the Motion of James S. Worrell, who spoke Court & deposed that Moses Worrell his Son-in-law, who justifies on Oath as to his Sufficiency, entered into & acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Eight hundred dollars, conditioned according to Law, which bond having a Stamp of the Seal, Rev. of the N. States to the amount of one dollar affixed thereto & duly Canonicalized, is ordered to be Canonicalized in penance the said James S. Worrell, for obtaining letters of Canonicalization on the Petition of Richard B. Thompson that he does good. It being declared and Oath that the estate real & personal does not exceed in Value the sum of \$1000.

George F. Bess is appointed Surgeon of the next trading year from to next in the place of James W. Shubert. And it is ordered that the next Court do not exceed.

Ordered That the acting Justice of this Court be summoned to the first day of the next Term, to consider the proposal for rebuilding of Gordon's Bridge, at the instance of Joseph Grayson.

Ordered That all the acting Justices of this Court be summoned to the first day of the next Term to consider the proposal for rebuilding of Gordon's Bridge, for the purpose of relieving and confirming the report of the Commissioners for the rebuilding of Camp Bridge.
