

This day came John Pottlow, who alleges that he is proprietor of an entry on the property late held by Mrs. Mono Commissioner of the Revenue for said County, at the year 1818, when his charge was £150. less for the year 1818, or £1000. which is the Commissioners charge both as income, and thereupon the said John Pottlow sends the last to remit him from the payment of the debt of £150. all of the land ~~annually~~, though against him for the said year 1818, when John was defendant by H.C. & C. the attorney for the Commissioner for said County, and the last time above the Commissioner who made the appearance, was examined as to whether his application, and it appearing that the last sum of £1000. was the present of sale of wife from his fund for 1819, & consequently intend to remit, and it appearing that application for relief against the excessive entry was made this day for the first time. All which the last witness is fully furnish upon the application aforesaid. In consideration whereof and for such facts so furnish, the County is satisfied that the said John Pottlow is consequently charged no debt except taxes amounting to £150. whereupon it is ordered that the said John Pottlow, be exonerated from the payment of £150. less the excessive charge, if not already paid, and if paid, that it be refunded to him.

Ordered that the following accounts in favour of same be sent, vizt. one amounting to £177 5s. another amounting to £4 4s. another amounting to £4 8d. another amounting to £10 10s. and another amounting to £10 10s. be certified to the Auditor of public accounts for his examination & payment.
