Jefferson J Woodard having claimed an attachment against the estate of Nancy Powell who intends to remove her effects out of this State so that there will not be sufficient effects to satisfy the plaintiff's demand of \$118.58 subject to credits which reduced to \$96.40 which will be due 21 December 1868 at 9% interest. And the plaintiff having made return that he has levied his said attachment on two barrels of Corn in the hands of Edwin Fille of about 600 lbs of good 200 lbs each in the hands of Peter Russell and also 9 barrels of Corn in the hands of Peter Russell. This day came the plaintiff by his attorney and the said Nancy Powell not appearing it is ordered by the Court that the plaintiff recover against the defendant \$96.40 and \$6.65 interest from the said 196.40 from 21 December 1868 till paid and his costs on this behalf expended and it is ordered that the officer who levied the said attachment make sale of the property attached and out of the money arising from such sale apply the same or as much thereof as sufficient to the satisfaction of this judgment and if the balance of any relates to the defendant and return an account of such to the Court.

Thomas R Postle having claimed an attachment against the estate of Edward Blunt who intends to remove or remove his effects out of this State so that there will not probably be sufficient effects left to satisfy the plaintiff's claim. And the Sheriff having returned that he had levied his said attachment on about 20 Bushels of Corn, 533 pounds dead weight and about 1800 pounds of Peas and one pair Corn wheels. This day came the plaintiff by his attorney and the defendant not appearing it is ordered that the plaintiff recover against the defendant \$50.65 interest from the said 21st day of November 1868 the amount of the plaintiff's claim and his costs by him on his behalf expended. And it is ordered that the Sheriff who levied the said attachment make sale of the property attached and apply the money arising from such sale or as much thereof as sufficient to the satisfaction of this judgment and the balance of any relates to the defendant and return an account of such sale to court.

Ordered that P Garrison, B. H. Gifford & Elliott W Ferguson being first duly sworn for the purpose do appear and all the goods & chattels of Charles R. Ferguson Esq and return the same unencumbered to the Clerk of this Court.

Ordered of Richard Brule. Ordered that he be sought from the payment of taxes & license and future being aged and infirm.
