Jefferson & Woodard having obtained an attachment against the estate of Henry Powell who intends to remove his effects out of this State so that there will not be therein sufficient effects to satisfy the plaintiff's demand of \$148.58 Subject to Credits which reduce it to \$96.20 which will be due 21st December 1868 \$96.16c. And the Constable having made return that he had levied the said attachment on two barrels of Corn in the hands of Edward Fells & about 600^{lbs} of fodder 22nd Dec^r & also in the hands of Philip Powell and also 9 barrels of Corn in the hand of Philip Powell This day came the plaintiff by his Attorney and the said Henry Powell not appearing it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff recovers against the Defendant \$96.20 and \$6.16c with interest on the said \$96.20 from 21st December 1868 till paid and his costs in this behalf expended And it is ordered that the officer who levied the said attachment make sale of the property attached and out of the moneys arising from such sale apply the same or as much thereof as is sufficient to the satisfaction of this judgment and the balance of any moneys to the Defendant and return an account of such sale to the Court.

Thomas R. Bond having obtained an attachment against the estate of Alfred Elliott who intends to remove or is removing his effects out of this State so that there will not probably be therein sufficient left to satisfy the plaintiff's claim And the Sheriff having returned that he had levied the said attachment on about 20 Bbls of Corn, 550 pounds said Cotton and about 1800 pounds of fodder and One Prairie Cow whale This day came the plaintiff by his Attorney and the Defendant not appearing it is ordered that the plaintiff recover against the Defendant \$50⁰⁰ with interest thereon from the 21st day of November 1868 the amount of the plaintiff's claim and his costs by him in this behalf expended And it is ordered that the Sheriff who levied the said attachment make sale of the property attached and apply the moneys arising from such sale or as much thereof as is sufficient to the satisfaction of this judgment and the balance of any moneys to the Defendant and return account of such sale to Court.

Ordered that S. Garver, B. B. Griffin & Elliot W. Ferguson being first duly sworn for the purpose do appraise all the goods & chattels of B. B. Ferguson do and return the appraisement under their hands to the Clerk of this Court.

On motion of Richard Bond Ordered that he be exempt from the payment of fees & costs in this case he being aged and infirm
