 interest in the land in question.

On the motion of Wm. A. Jones who made according to law and together with Joseph D. Mays &
 William M. Brinton his Sureties (who justified on oath as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowl-
 edged a bond in the penalty of one hundred & fifty dollars conditioned according to
 law, which bond bearing a Stamp of the Internal Revenue of the United States
 to the amount of one dollar affixed thereto & duly cancelled is ordered to be
 recorded. Certificate is granted to the said Wm. A. Jones for obtaining letters of
 administration on the estate of William A. Jones, dec. (deceased) in due form.
 It being declared on oath that the estate and personal does not exceed in value
 the sum of \$1000.

On the motion of Elliott S. Stong, who made oath according to law & together with
 Elijah J. Williams & George Moore his Sureties (who justified on oath as to their sufficiency)
 entered into & acknowledged a bond in the penalty of one hundred dollars, conditioned
