

The Court do recommend the proposal for the rebuilding of Justice's bridge, & a meeting being presently the Court again considered what respects to recommend the said proposal.

On the Motion of James Barnes, Richard L. Bryant is appointed as Justice in the Court of Alexander's Court, (who has since died,) in a Suit of Debt returned by Ed. Hall on 16th May 1866, & records in the Clerk's Office of Southampton County Court.

The Court doth assign James B. Vicks, Quartermaster of Samuel A. Vicks, William A. Vicks, Susan B. Vicks, Mary S. Vicks & Richard E. Vicks, Captains of Robert Vicks and And removed the said James B. Vicks, entered into a bond in the penalty of Five Hundred dollars, Conditioned according to law, with Seal of Scotland, James Kille, C. C. Williams & Henry S. Howard his Securities, which bond being acknowledged by the Obligors & secured, is ordered to be recorded. A Stamp of the Int. Rev. of the United States to the amount of two dollars being affixed to said bond and duly Conditioned.

The last Will & Testament of Charles F. Vignatour died, & his Executors named Francis, and bearing date 20th day of February 1867, and the said bearing date the 20th day of December 1867, were presented to the Court, and the said will and the executor bearing date the 20th day of December 1867, was proved by the Oaths of James E. Selnes and A. P. Atkins, Subscribing witnesses thereof, & the executor bearing date 20th day of February 1867, was proved by the Oaths of Dr. Ridley and A. P. Atkins the Subscribing witnesses thereof, and ordered to be recorded as the last Will & Testament & Certificate thereof of Charles F. Vignatour died. And on the Motion of William Vignatour & J. W. Vignatour, the Executors named in the said Will who have both according to law & entered into a acknowledged & bond in the penalty of Five Hundred Dollars, Conditioned according to law, the said demanding no Security to be required of them, & the bond requiring none, which bond bearing a Stamp of the Int. Rev. of the United States to the amount of two dollars being affixed thereto & duly Conditioned is ordered to be recorded. Certificate is granted to said William Vignatour & J. W. Vignatour, as Executors of the said Will in and from a Stamp of the Int. Rev. of the United States to the amount of \$12.50 being affixed thereto and duly Conditioned.

Ordered that Henry M. Davis, James E. Selnes, A. P. Atkins, and Wm. W. Coby, & any three of them, being first duly sworn for the purpose, do appraise all the goods & chattels of the estate of Charles F. Vignatour died, & return the appraisement under their hands to the Clerk of this Court.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term.
