

The said Comptroller in the premises, who report to the Court, at the next term in due & proper season.

At the Office of District Clerk, Sheriff of the County of James W. Williams & James C. Wells, do hereby certify that the following are the names of the said James W. Williams & James C. Wells, both of which are provided by Law.

Ordered that the said charge of being the father of a bastard child of which Margaret Spring was delivered on the 19th day of October 1865, appeared in Court upon discharge of his recognizance, and was before a Justice of the Peace, and the said Margaret Spring & William Williams were sworn & examined, and the said Judge of the Peace heard the Court upon the circumstances of the case, and adjudge that the said Margaret Spring is not the father of the said bastard child, therefore it is ordered that the said Complaint be dismissed.

Ordered that James C. Bennett, Daniel W. Cobby, and Christopher J. Siddle, do by to the Court, undertake the repairs or rebuilding of Camp Bridge and report to the Court, & it is ordered that the Sheriff of this County summon the aforesaid Justices to the first day of the next Term to satisfy or report the same.

Ordered that the Sheriff out of any contingent money in his hands not otherwise appropriated pay to John C. Griffin seven dollars for repairs to Swamp Bridge.

At the Office of Miller B. Barrett, he is authorized to straighten the road, from Vineyard Hill to Seacock Bridge, running through said Barrett's land, and when the said is straightened & put in good repair & secured by the fences of said road that the same be established as a public highway, & the old road be discontinued.

Ordered that the Sheriff out of any contingent money in his hands <sup>not otherwise appropriated</sup> pay to John C. Griffin seven dollars for repairs on Camp Bridge and to James C. Bennett for the last eighteen months.

The Court recommends John C. Bennett to be Constable in the 2d Ward of the Town of New York in the place of Henry J. White who failed to qualify.

Ordered that the account of Allen Bradley & Joseph Roden amounting to four dollars, be certified to the Auditor of Public accounts for his examination & payment.

The Court taking into consideration the report of the Comptroller appointed to take the rebuilding of Broad Water Bridge, and the aforesaid Justices having been summoned for the purpose, do hereby certify that the said Comptroller entered into a contract, between the County & the undertaker of the said Bridge & take said & the same of the said undertaker according to Law & return the same to Court.

Ordered that the Sheriff of this County summon all the aforesaid Justices to the first day of the next Term to take into consideration the rebuilding
