

The Court Comfined in the forenoon, and adjourned at 12 o'clock, at the time a Writ to Sheriff James E. Gillett was issued by the County of Orange, Sheriff of the County James T. Williams & James H. Clegg, appointed to qualify as his deputies and thereupon the said James T. Williams & James H. Clegg, took the Oath presented by Justice

Sheriff who then charged of being the Clerk of a certain chit of which Margaret Spring was delivered on the 19th day of October 1868, appeared in Court, after discharge of his jury, and came into Court a Justice of the Peace, and the said Margaret Spring & husband George Lewis were examined, and the said Sheriff swore fully, based on the testimony of the said, that the said George Lewis is not the father of the said Margaret Spring, therefore it is Ordered that the said Complaint be dismissed.

Ordered that James E. Gillett, Samuel H. Clegg and Christopher G. Sibley do lay to the County under their the repair or rebuilding of Long Bridge and repair to the same, & it is Ordered that the Sheriff of this County summon the acting Justices to the first day of the next Term to satisfy in regard the same.

Ordered that the Sheriff lay of any Contingent money in his hands ready wherein appropriated pay to John C. Griffin Seven Dollars for expenses to Joseph Swamp Bridge.

In the opinion of Miles B. Barnard, he is authorized to Straighten the road, from Vaughan's Store to Second Bridge, running through said Barnard's land, and when the said is Straightened & put in good repair & secured by the owners of said road that the same be established as a public highway, & the old road be discontinued.

Ordered that the Sheriff lay of any Contingent money in his hands ^{of the County} for repairing Second Bridge fifteen dollars for expenses in hiring of Attorney and of Journeyman, for the last eighteen months.

The County recommends Peter Brown to be Constable on the 3^d Magisterial District in the County in the place of Henry J. White who failed to qualify.

Ordered that the account of Alvin Bradley & Jeptha Rodde amounting to four dollars, be certified to the Auditor of Public accounts for his examination & payment.

The Court taking into Consideration the report of Commissioners appointed to lay the rebuilding of Broad Water Bridge over the acting Justice having been summoned for the purpose, doth resolve & Confirm the said report. And it is Ordered that the Commissioners enter into a Contract between the County & the manufacturer of the said Bridge & take bond & security of the said manufacturer according to Law to return the same to County.

Ordered that the Sheriff of this County summon all the acting Justices to the first day of the next Term to take into Consideration the rebuilding
