Ordered that William A. Hays, J. B. Higgins & C. C. Vanglass, who are hereby appointed
the Special Commissioners for the purpose, do let to the Town, under their the Bridge
over Chesham's Creek, & the Bridge at Oak Point Creek & report to the next term of
the Court.

Ordered that William F. Adams, Lewis E. Shaw & Thomas M. Hays, who
are hereby appointed Commissioners for the purpose, do let to the Town, under
their the rebuilding of the two Bridges across the Swamp in the next looking
from S. M. Haysville & the Bridge across the Swamp in the next looking from
Oak Haysville to Lewis E. Shaw & report to the next term of the Court.

Ordered that all the riding justices of this County be summoned to the first day
of the next Term to deliver jurors to serve for the next ensuing term within

Ordered that the account of Richard H. Brinkley, Constable of Mansfield County, amounting
to \$12.50 be certified to the Auditor of Public Accounts for his examination
& payment.

On Motion of William J. Hays, Guardian of Virginia A. Johnson, she is allowed
to expend the sum of \$50. out of the principal of her estate for her
support & maintenance for the year 1869.
