

On the Motion of J. E. Smith, W. Adams, J. H. Smith, T. J. Smith, Walter B. Adams, Chas. W. Williams, Franklin Smith, & James J. Adams vs. James J. Adams, for leave to return writs of Habeas Corpus & also respecting the same, the Court being satisfied that the same is to be left in the hands of the Court & not the defendant, the Court ordered that the writs of Habeas Corpus be granted.
