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This debt abated at the Rules as in that defendant Burt and the judgment allowed at the Rules against the defendant Bryant not having been set aside and the plaintiff being now entitled to a final judgment it is therefore considered and said that the plaintiff recover against the said Defendant Bryant Eighty four dollars the debt in the declaration mentioned with legal interest thereon from the 12 day of March 1867 till paid and his costs by him about his debt in this behalf expended.
