It being suggested to the Court that since the last order entered in this cause No W. Journe one of the plaintiffs has departed this life, on motion of P. G. R. another of the plaintiffs by his counsel it is ordered that the sum due for as No W. Journe is concerned stand ready in the name of Adel Journe his Administrator, and that it hereafter be pronounced in his name.

On the Motion of Patrick Dow. Order is set the Administration Estate of Edward Payne deceased to be committed to the hands of T. L. Toly, Sheriff of York County to be administered according to law.

On the Motion of David H. Webster against W. G. Gray, guardian of Richard, Henry L. & Benjamin S. Gray this day came the parties by their attorney who being fully heard, it is Ordered by the Court that the said W. G. Gray make a new bond with good Security and the penalty of Fifteen thousand dollars, conditioned according to law, whereupon the said W. G. Gray, with Joseph Gray & Horace E. Johnson his Sureties, (to whom also is now paid as to their Sureties) entered into & acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Fifteen thousand dollars, conditioned according to law, which bond having a stamp of the Sub. Ass't of the U.S. to the amount of one dollar being affixed thereto, duly executed is Ordered to be recorded. It being known to the Court the Estate of the said Stephen Gray deceased left of the sum of One Thousand dollars, only named the value of Fifteen hundred dollars. And it is Ordered that the said W. G. Gray pay to the said D. H. Webster the costs of this prosecution.

Order is made that G. A. Applewhite, J. M.
