Certificate is granted the said Robert M. Dolan for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of the late Patrick Dolan deceased in due form. It being declared no Cash has been paid & affixed for, or in respect to which said letters of administration affixed for have exceeded the sum of Four hundred dollars.

Ordered, that & by James, A. T. Stephen, A. W. Spring, James E. Bradbury, being duly sworn for the purpose, any sum of whom may be, do appraise all the goods & chattels of the Estate of Patrick Dolan deceased & return the appraisement under their hands to the Clerk of this Court.
