

Ordered that Josiah B. Brown, to be William & Henry Dugan, be and they are hereby appointed Commissioners, (any two of whom may act,) for the purpose of taking up to the lowest bidder the repairs of the old Embankment & the rebuilding of the Bridge, the said Embankment to Commence at the foot of the Bridge and follow the Highway of Jerusalem on the West Side of said river, not following as nearly as possible the line of the old Embankment, the said Embankment to be at least six feet above high water mark, and (9) feet broad at top, and usual base for Embankment of this width, suitable Slopes - And the said Commissioners and hereby empowered, if they think the fit to employ the Services of some Civil Engineer or Surveyor, to report to them the Cost of the Embankment & the Bridge, the said Engineer or Surveyor to be paid for his Services by the County, & the said Commissioners and Ordered to report their proceedings, together with the Contract they may enter into, to the Court, no later than the first of March. And the Court do hereby order that the sum of Fifty thousand dollars, be laid out this term, as a Contingent fund, to be applied, if the Contract the above Commissioners may make, be subject, to the payment of the Contractor.

Ordered that the Sheriff Summon all the Freeholders of this County to the first day of the next term to take into Consideration the Contract of one Thomas de Meade for building and Embankment and Bridges on the West Side of Highway near Jerusalem.

Ordered that the account of Josiah B. Sheriff, amounting to Twelve dollars, of Samuel Wells Sheriff, amounting to Twelve dollars & fifty Cents, & of Saml B. Smith, amounting to Seven dollars & fifty Cents, be certified to the Auditors of Public accounts, for his examination & payment.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term.
