Barnes & Henry Barnes, who have removed their affairs out of this State,
so that there was property, not to them to satisfy the claim of the said
J. W. Barnes, of two hundred dollars, whose judgment is obtained therefor,
shewed only the ordinary process of law he used to obtain such
judgment, and the Officer to whom the said attachment was directed,
having returned that he seized the same as directed, returned & twenty eight
pounds of said cotton this day, came the plaintiff and the said Defendant
being solemnly called and not appearing, it is considered by the Court,
that the plaintiff recover against the Defendant two hundred dollars and
costs incurred thereon from January the 11th 1819, less fees and charges in
this suit actually expended. And it is ordered that the Officer who seized
the said attachment, make sale of the effects seized upon according
to law and out of the proceeds arising from said sale pay & satisfy the
judgment, and the shipping of any residue to the Defendant.
And that he return an account of said sale to the Court.

The Complainant appeared to the Court and shewed the shipping of
cotton from the 17th of October 1819, this day upon their report.
Which report the Court refused to accept, but reports the same.

Ordered that J. L. S. Sheriff, Edwin Langdon & Joseph C. Warren, be and they
are hereby appointed Complainants for that purpose, to take the same
and shew to the Court the same from the 17th of October 1819, and upon their report.
Which report the Court refused to accept, but reports the same.
And the Court ordered that the Sheriff take in to his hands the said
the above and report and of the expiration of the said, shew to the Court
the said and report is to be so, this proceeding of the Court.

Ordered that J. L. S. Sheriff of this County, take into his hands
the Estate of Solomon Perkins (Colon) and administer the same
according to law.
