

Ordered that Thomas A. Butler, John Butler and William Bennett be and they are hereby appointed Commissioners to bid to the land West of the (the land) and upon at the expense of the County) the work of embankment, near Chapinburg's mill, or near the lower bridge, across the Mill race, and make report to Court.

Ordered that D. J. Bryants, E. B. Post, Joseph Sadding and A. H. Cotton, be and they are hereby appointed Commissioners to bid to the land, West of the bridge of the Ferry at Millers, for the term of twelve months from the 31st of December 1849, and make report to the Court.

On Motion of Jacob Williamson, It is Ordered that Charles W. Wadsworth administrator of Jacobus Wadsworth dec'd. pay to the said Jacob Williamson, the balance due him for board and clothing of the children of the said Jacobus Wadsworth for the year 1849.

As the Judges of the County being summoned for the purpose and a majority being present, the Court took into consideration the report of the Commissioners, about the rebuilding of the upper bridge, and after debate and conference the Court - also the Order that the Commissioners to wit, Parker I. Story, Jos. W. Thomas and Jonathan Sadding, take from D. J. Bryants the Certificate and with sufficient Security in the sum of \$2000.00) pay to the County of Southampton and conditioned for the said four Commissioners of the Certificate and return the said Certificate with their report to the Court.

The Court Corroborated the following evidence presented before it, that Harrison Jones to whom County Land Warrant, No. 49, 958 and dated 17 December 1846, for 100 acres in Captain Baines Company, Virginia Militia, Nov. 1812, for 100 acres, is the same identical person who acquired the said Warrant @ Harrison Jones and sold it to the Judge as Harrison Jones.
