

The Commissioners appointed to act to the Court under letters of the

the Prob. to the amount of two dollars approved thereof and duly certified,

doubts and entered into a Bond in the penalty of two thousand dollars,
conditioned according to law, with Geo. H. Spring his Sureties, (who
participated in said as to his Sufficiency) and which said bond being
acknowledgeed by the Plaintiff therein, is ordered to be recorded.
Conditionally granted the said Chas. H. C. Bailey for obtaining letters of
administration for the Estate of Thomas English dead in due form.
It being shown that the Estate and affairs for and in respect to which
such letters of administration applied for does not exceed the value of fifteen

hundred dollars. Wm. Jackson, et al. Executors, et al. J. Stephenson, et al. E. Stephenson
in any store of above things, being found duly sworn for their purposes,
do approve and act the goods of Charles H. English dead
and deliver the appraisement rendered their hands to the
Clerk of this Court.

On the Motion of And E. Spring, who signed Bond in the law
doubts and entered into a Bond in the penalty of seven hundred dollars,
conditioned according to law, with And E. and Jackson above his
Sureties, (who participated in said as to their Sufficiency) and which
said bond being acknowledgeed by the Plaintiff therein is ordered to be
recorded. Conditionally granted the said And E. Spring for obtaining
letters of administration to the Estate of And E. Spring dead in due
form. It being shown that the Estate and affairs for and in respect
to which such letters of administration applied for does not
exceed the value of fifteen hundred dollars. And it is ordered that the Order
heretofore made committing the Estate of the said And E. Spring
to Wm. H. Briggs, Sheriff of this County for admin-
istering be and the same is hereby recorded.

On the Motion of James H. H., a party interested, the Court did appoint
Order and decree that Wm. H. Briggs be and he is hereby appointed
Judge Clerk in a certain deed of Trust of record in the Clerk's
Office of said respective County executed by James H. H.
