The Commissioners appointed to the care and repair of the old Embankment and the rebuilding of the Bridge in the West side of Newbury River and to take care of the Under-laying. This day made their report about the cost of repair.

It appearing to the Court that the Report of the Commissioners of this County in Regd. E. Womels Transactions as administrator of Robert L. Barnes has been submitted to this Court for exceptions, and also that the said Commissioners Report of the old Embankment against the title of the said Robert L.
