

Robert Spinks is the owner in this country. It appearing to the Court that the place where the same is to be built is suitable and convenient, and that the applicant is a person of standing and good character.

At the request of James Sumner and for reasons appearing to the Court, It is ordered that he be discharged from the payment of Taxes and County Levies in future, his being aged and infirm.

At the request of Henry Watkins et al. and for reasons appearing to the Court It is ordered that he be exempted from the payment of Taxes and County Levies in future, his being aged and infirm.

Ordered that C. F. Horton, D. G. Harwood and J. G. Goodenough be and they are hereby appointed Commissioners to act in conjunction with Commissioners appointed by the County Court of State of Ohio, to act to the several towns within the respective jurisdictions of Hamilton County, receive the same when completed, and make report to the Court.

Ordered that the Sheriff of this County out of any contingent monies in his hands, be and he is authorized to pay to the several towns the sum of Five hundred and fifty Eight Dollars, for retrenching the several Water Bridges.

Ordered that J. C. Williams be appointed Commissioner to act to the several towns within the jurisdiction of this County, and to the several towns within the jurisdiction of Hamilton County, receive the same when completed, and make report to the Court.

The Court doth affirm Royal R. Howard Guardian to Edward Holt & Effie Holt executors of John J. Holt dec'd and discharge the said John J. Holt dec'd & William B. Lamb his executor (who justified on oath as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One thousand dollars conditioned according to law. It appearing to the Court that the value of the estate & effects of the said John J. Holt dec'd do not exceed one thousand dollars.

On the motion of James C. Sumner who made oath according to law and together with George T. Sumner his security (who justified on oath as to his sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Five thousand dollars conditioned according to law, which bond is ordered to be recorded. Certificate is granted the said James C. Sumner for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Charles Cook dec'd in due form. It being declared that the estate and effects of the said Charles Cook dec'd do not exceed one thousand dollars.

Ordered that John H. Adams, John A. North, Edward Venable & N. B. Henderson or any three of them being first duly sworn for the purpose do appraise all the goods & chattels of Charles Cook dec'd and return the appraisement under their hands to the Clerk of this Court.

On the motion of Harriet M. Howell who made oath according to law and together with David Ferguson her security (who justified on oath as to his sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Five thousand dollars conditioned according to law, which bond is ordered to be recorded. Certificate is granted the said Harriet M. Howell for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of John B. Howell dec'd in due form. It being declared that the estate and effects of the said John B. Howell dec'd do not exceed one thousand dollars.
